He has also held the role of Chief Information and Technology Officer at AlixPartners, Taubman, and with the Enterprise Activities Group at General Motors. Osment helped to define "Smart Malls" and has led the way in developing fiber optic infrastructure to deliver new services and cut energy usage two-fold.
